



PUBLIC CODE OF CONDUCT FOR A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE FESTIVAL EVENT

- **PARKING** – Festival parking is available in the Parking Structure on First Street, along streets in the Village and other designated City lots. There is **no event parking** allowed on Cornell Avenue or Oberlin Avenue or in neighborhoods to the west of the Festival. Vehicles in violation may be towed at owners' expense.
- **DISALLOWED** - We're sorry, but health and safety codes forbid the presence of **pets** (except service animals), **skateboards**, **roller blades** or **bicycles** on Festival grounds. Bicycles may be walked along sidewalks and parked and locked at designated bike racks.
- **NO LITTERING PLEASE** – An untidy street reflects poorly on us all, and could pose a threat to health or safety. Violators may be fined. Please deposit your trash in waste receptacles along event route.
- **PUBLIC SAFETY** - We are committed to providing a safe and enjoyable event for our Guests and Booth Participants. Any individual or group whose behavior is disruptive or a danger to other Festival participants will be asked to leave. In the event that such individual or group refuses, said will be removed from the premises by law enforcement officers.
- **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** – The consumption of alcohol is expressly prohibited on Festival grounds. Anyone who attempts to enter with alcohol, or appears to be intoxicated, may be refused admittance or may be removed from the Festival.
- **NO UNLAWFUL ACTIVITIES** will be tolerated on Festival grounds.
- **NO FIREARMS OR WEAPONS** - Except for security personnel as permitted by law, firearms and weapons of every type are expressly forbidden on Festival grounds.
- **DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS** – The Celebrate Claremont Family Festival is a private, permitted event open to the public and only commercial or non-profit organizations with assigned booth space may distribute information and free items.
- **NO BUSKING** – The Festival is proud to provide entertainment and no unapproved busking is allowed. Those interested in entertaining at the event may contact the Event Manager at the Sponsor Information Booth on the west side of Oberlin at First Street, Booth Number 1.
- **ENFORCEMENT** – Any individual or group in violation of the preceding will be asked to cease and desist or to leave Festival grounds. In the event that such individual or group refuses, said will be removed from the premises by law enforcement officers.
